VDC Team Servant Training

As the training coordinator for the Utah VDC Secretariat, I wanted to give some clarification as to how the preparation of the spring weekends flows.

The Spring Rector and Rectora will be selected by the Secretariat during December, based upon prayer and on the involvement and experience that candidates have had during previous weekends. After much prayer, these persons will, hopefully, accept the call. It is our hope that by the time of the first full team meeting most members of all of the team have agreed to serve and have cleared their calendars for the dates below:


