Hello 4th Day Community,

Are you sponsoring or considering sponsoring? The joy of watching someone's walk with Jesus deepen through a weekend is a gift and a blessing. The sponsor and a weekender's relationship are unique and special beyond what words can describe. It is more than giving a coffee cup and going to dinner.

Many think that the best way to serve during the weekend is to be on a team serving at the church. Sponsoring is a team within itself. It is not a team that formally meets to train. It is not a team that has a Rector or Rectora. It is the 4th Day community members called by God to seek out that special someone to attend the weekend and honor Gods call when it is given.

As I stated before, sponsoring is not just dinner and a coffee cup. The Utah VDC website has a download available on sponsor responsibilities. Please review it if you are considering sponsoring, but here are a few key points to remember when sponsoring.

- A weekender needs to be a believer. The National VDC guidelines state the weekends are for baptized believers.
- The weekender needs to be physically able to handle the weekend. The weekend puts a strain on all that are involved both mentally and physically. We will not turn away a weekender because of a physical challenge, but ask that the sponsor is available to assist during the weekend if the weekender's physical challenges become more than the Rollo Room can handle; basically being on call as needed.
- Please do not work on a team if you are sponsoring.
- Turn in the application for your weekender early. Applications can be downloaded at www.utahvdc.org. It is not the responsibility of the sponsor to pay for the weekender to attend. If there is an issue with a weekender unable to pay please contact a Secretariat member for assistance.
- Pray with your weekender before the weekend. Initiate a deeper relationship with them prior to the weekend.
- Be available and keep in contact with the weekender after the weekends are done.
- Assist your weekender in finding a renewal group. Debbie Baum oversees the renewal group process for the Secretariat. She is a great resource in helping you find a renewal group for your weekender.
- Be honest about the weekends. If your weekender has a question of what happens during the weekend, tell them. You don't have to disclose all the events in detail, but please do not keep anything a secret. The weekend is an experience. We have the same outline for each weekend. It allows God to come in and brings us all to our knees at different moments of the weekend.
