It's About TIME!

We are quickly approaching the season in which a new group must be identified to serve on the Secretariat (Board) for the Utah Via De Cristo Community. My quess is

that for a fleeting moment you felt a nudge from a friend (perhaps our BIG FRIEND) to consider the possibility. Perhaps just as quickly, you dismissed the idea, with a quick determination that you did not have the talent, the intelligence, the motivation or the energy for such a commitment. Give me a bit of time and just maybe you will reexamine that conclusion.

Talent - God does not call us to things we already do with excellence. He becomes the excellence in the things he calls us to do. I personally felt deficient in my skill set for many of the areas that have been my responsibility during the 3 years I have served. I learned much and felt a supernatural increase in my abilities as I prayed to be able to serve God and his people. Along the way I gained new talents which have enhanced other areas of my life. Intelligence - Because there is a full team of Secretariat members, we can rely upon each other to fill in the blanks that our own

experience or education seem inadequate to address. We thus learn while growing to appreciate the wisdom of others. Being aware of the inner workings and background efforts that go into VDC adds greatly to our understanding.

Motivation - Many of us feel like we have too many other responsibilities to make time for actions like serving on a board. "Boring", "not for me", "I have more important things to do" and "Not until I am retired" are some responses to suggestions of serving on the VDC Secretariat. One of the outgoing members gave a rebuttal to that attitude when he explained that his experience was surprisingly satisfying. He said that going through a weekend was wonderful but that serving on a team for a weekend surpassed that by far. Serving on the Secretariat was, for him, a third and higher level of growth in his Christian walk.

Energy - The Holy Spirit is strongly present in any and all happenings of Via De Cristo. Just as attending a Renewal Group or Ultreya can fill your cup to overflowing, the gathering of Christian men and women committed to the mission of VDC is a recharging of energy. Every month we experience the fellowship, the prayer, the worship, the spiritual connectedness that is at the core of loving Christ and serving his people.

The Spring weekend is less than 3 months away! Now is the time to pray about sponsoring.



Who is a sponsor?

A sponsor is a 4th Day community member who supports a weekender up to, during and after their Via de Cristo weekend.

What does a sponsor do?

- Answer questions about the Via de Cristo weekend experience
- Pray for the weekender before, during, and after the weekend
- Have dinner and transport the weekender to the weekend
- Provide a mug and note of encouragement at the start of the weekend
- Write a bed palanca letter to the weekender
- Attend the Sponsor Hour service
- Sign bibles for the weekenders
- Attend the 5:30 am Sunday morning serenade
- Attend the lunch serenade and Closura
- Take weekender home
- Check on weekender during the first week; answer any questions
