Utah VDC Spring Weekend Report

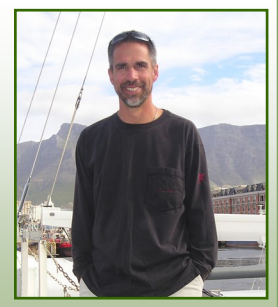

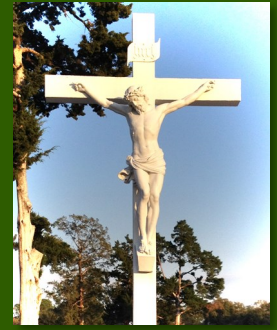

Agape Dinner Honey Baked Chicken

Ingredients

- 1/2 cup honey
- 2 Tablespoons butter
- 1 Tablespoon Dijon mustard
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 4 boneless/skinless chicken breasts

Directions

Combine honey, butter, mustard and salt in a saucepan. Heat on low, stirring until butter is melted and ingredients are well combined. Place chicken in shallow baking dish sprayed with cooking spray. Pour honey mixture over chicken and bake 30 minutes in preheated 350 degree oven.
