Trainer & Training Coordinator Job Description

Hi, I'm Kelly Martin and for the last year I've had the pleasure of serving as the Trainer/Training Coordinator for the Utah VdC Community. As trainer I contact churches to coordinate the locations and dates for our trainings.

Our trainings are broken down into several sections. When the Rector/Rectora are selected they receive training, then they select the leaders for the weekend. Leaders are trained and then they select team members to serve on the weekends.




We also hold a Servant Training once a year.
Servant Training is primarily for new weekenders.
We talk more in depth about the 4th Day

sponsorship.



Allocations Job Description

Allocations seems like an odd name for this position. Maybe it's because you are allocating a space to a lucky Weekender.

Allocations involves receiving and acknowledging all applications for the weekends. Once the deadline arrives, all applications are reviewed, ideally by a committee. Priority is given to couples attending the weekend, members of the Lutheran faith, and then



all other applicants are considered. An acceptance letter is sent to each potential Weekender and the lists of Weekenders are forwarded to the Rector and Rectora. Contribution checks are received and given to the respective treasurers.

Other duties include maintenance and distribution of the application form and alerting the community of the application deadline for the weekends. Also, attending Secretariat meetings.

Ultreya/Liaison Coordinator Needed

This position is filled by an elected member of the VDC Council and is a voting member of the Council. Denise McConkey was in this position. She resigned when she moved to Las Vegas. Bonnie Kundson and Candace Hockett are filling this until VDC Council elections.

The Ultreya/Liason Coordinator is called to be the hands and feet of Jesus. The Liaison is the key link between the 4th day community, congregations, pastors, sponsors, small groups, potential weekenders and the Via de Cristo Council. The Liaisons are called to encourage, be compassionate, accept all and serve. The church liaisons represent the Via de Cristo Community in their church. They generate interest in VDC, answer questions, provide applications for weekends, and publicize upcoming events. They are the face of VDC in their churches.

The Coordinator also finds the locations for the monthly Ultreyas. The Coordinator works with the church liaisons to to organize speakers, musicians, kitchen and clergy help and church facilities for the Ultreya. The Ultreyas are usually the 3rd Sunday of the month.
