Greetings VDC community! The IRS has reviewed tax topic 506 as of December 12, 2013 concerning charitable deductions. After reviewing the IRS rulings and discussions with a local CPA, we on the Secretariat feel confident in our analysis that the fair market value (FMV) of a weekend be listed as \$149.00. **This analysis does not affect the cost of the weekend for team-members or weekenders. The suggested participation fee is still \$100.00!**

The analysis is based on the following:

8 meals @ \$8.00 each

3 night's accommodations @ 20.00 each

\$25.00 in tangible materials

Monetary donations collected as JOG at an Ultreya or sent directly through the mail are still considered 100% tax deductible as are any scholarship monies donated in order for someone other than yourself to participate in a weekend.
